- To treat tires, apply by hand or carefully spray surface.
- Avoid buildup at rim or tread.
- For other surfaces, apply a light coating of dressing and wipe to ensure a consistent appearance.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q1. Is TireNu2™ Body Shop Safe?

A1. Yes, TireNu2 contains no silicone and should cause no paint defect to occur if used as directed.

Q2. What is different from TireNu 1 vs. TireNu2?

A2. TireNu2 should dry significantly faster than the original version and should stay glossier for a longer period of time.

Q3. Can TireNu2 be used on other surfaces besides tires?

A3. TireNu2 is a solvent based formula that may react with some interior surface that have been dyed so Malco recommends testing in an inconspicuous area before applying to any or all surfaces.

Q4. Will the product sling and what happens if it does?

A4. The product was designed to dry more quickly to reduce the chances of sling but if there is build up around the rim area or in the texture of the tire sling could occur. If sling does occur Malco recommends removing the product immediately from any painted surface in order to protect surface from any possible staining that could occur from solvents or materials in the tire that could leach out and stain painted surfaces.

Q5. How long can I expect the product to last?

A5. This product can last up to 30 days with ideal weather conditions. Being that the product is solvent based it should resist light rain showers but could wash off in heavy rain or snow.
